- Number of years as an active member.
- Dates and Degrees conferred as a member.

- Individual contributions to Ag program. Projects and activities of the Chapter, Section, State, or Regional levels (Such as committees and judging teams).
- Individual contributions to school, community, or leadership projects.

You must submit with your application:

- Three letters of recommendation including one from your leader or advisor.
- Copy of official school transcript with overall GPA.
- Essay
- 5x7 photo of you and your current project (Optional)***

Please read and follow these guidelines when filling out your application. Following these guidelines will greatly enhance your chance of becoming a successful applicant. The deadline to submit your application is March 31st.

Please type your application and personal essay, paying close attention to spelling and grammar. The neatness and completeness will be evaluated. The more information you provide us, the easier it will be for us to evaluate your application. The application asks for information regarding your college/university experience and your involvement in the agriculture industry.

Please include a one-page (no more than two) page essay including your:

- Accomplishments
- Educational goals
- Career objectives
- And briefly explain why you have made these choices.
- Two letters of recommendation to be included with your application.
- A 5x7 photo of you that will be used on the TCA website and Facebook in the event that you are selected for a scholarship. (The photo will have no factor in the selection process.)

Please include your current overall GPA along with your GPA in Ag classes. It is also necessary to enclose your current official college transcript showing your declared major. We may conduct a phone interviewer of prospective applicants prior to choosing a recipient. Be prepared to answer questions on Agriculture related topics. It would be beneficial for you to know about our organization.

If you are applying for both the TCA and PNCW University Scholarships, you will need to complete an application for each organization and submit separately. For PNCW information please refer to the website <u>www.pncw.org</u>.
